Featured Student Organization of the Week: Partnership, Excellence & Academics (P.E.A.)

Partnership, Excellence & Academics (commonly referred to as "P.E.A.") was established at the UConn in 2003 as an interest group with the intent to bring a historically Jewish sorority to campus. While the organization seeks to maintain a Jewish affiliation, PEA encourages and welcomes girls of all religious affiliations. PEA has developed around the core values of Greek Life- scholarship, service, leadership, and sisterhood. To maintain the goals and objectives of PEA, the members continuously participate in philanthropic events, community service, social events with other Greek organizations, and sisterhood events throughout the academic year.



In Spring of 2006, PEA earned affiliate membership into the University of Connecticut's Panhellenic Council, the governing council for the six national sororities on campus. The girls of PEA continued to strive to attain status of a national sorority. On November 13th, 2006, the University of Connecticut's Panhellenic Council voted and approved the decision to help PEA find a home with a national sorority and extended an invitation to Alpha Epsilon Phi to colonize on UConn's campus. In the upcoming spring of 2007 semester, PEA will officially become a colony of the nationally Jewish sorority, Alpha Epsilon Phi.
