outreach opportunities, intramurals and more, there's guaranteed to be something for everyone!! See you at the Fair!!

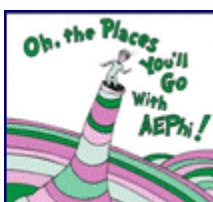
Volunteers Needed! Check Out Spring 2007 Community Service Days!
